A key aspect of injury prevention is identification of high risk activities and then educating employees on proper work techniques (ergonomics) to prevent injuries. Our network has doctors who have over 13 years experience in workplace safety programs.

These services, which are available at no charge to employers, include:

Ergonomic Studies

A job site inspection to identify high risk areas. It is recommended that the person who processes injury claims be available to help identify “hot spots.”

On Site Injury Prevention Programs

A custom program is developed with job site inspection and is specifically tailored to meet individual employer needs.

Includes instruction on proper ergonomics for office staff / computer users.

Lifting and safety programs for labor orientated jobs.

These programs help fulfill the safety and education requirements mandated by OSHA and Senate Bill 198.
